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1. Important Information

- 1.1. This E-Auction/Tender Document has been issued pursuant to notification of an area with the intent to carry out e-auction for grant of a quarry Lease for minor mineral block(s) as mentioned in the (**Annexure –I**) pursuant to the Act and the rules framed there under. All information provided in this E-Auction/Tender Document should be read together with the Act and the rules framed there under. In the event of a conflict between this E-Auction/Tender Document and the Act or the rules, the Act or the rules (as amended from time to time), as the case may be, shall prevail.
- 1.2. The information contained in this E-Auction/Tender Document or subsequently provided to Bidder(s), whether in documentary or any other form by or on behalf of the Competent Authority or any of its employees or advisors, is provided to Bidder(s) on the terms and conditions set out in this E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 1.3. The purpose of this E-Auction/Tender Document is to provide interested parties with information that may be useful to them in making their bids pursuant to this E-Auction/Tender Document. This E-Auction/Tender Document includes statements which reflect various assumptions and assessments arrived at by the Competent authority in relation to the mineral source and information collated from various sources, some of which may depend upon interpretation of Applicable Law.
- 1.4. The assumptions, assessments, statements and information contained in the E-Auction/Tender Document may not be complete or adequate. Each Bidder should, therefore, conduct its own investigations and analysis and should check the accuracy, adequacy, correctness, reliability and completeness of the assumptions, assessments, statements and information contained in this E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 1.5. The Competent Authority shall have no liability or responsibility to any person, including any Bidder under any law, statute, rules or regulations or tort, principles of restitution or unjust enrichment or otherwise for any loss, damages, cost or expense which may arise from or be incurred or suffered on account of anything contained in this E-Auction/Tender Document or otherwise. The Competent Authority also accepts no liability of any nature howsoever caused arising from reliance of any Bidder upon the statements contained in this E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 1.6. The Competent Authority may in its absolute discretion, but without being under any obligation to do so, update, amend or supplement the information, assessment or assumptions contained in this E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 1.7. The issue of this E-Auction/Tender Document does not imply that the Competent Authority is bound to select a Bidder as Selected Bidder for the mineral block and the State Government reserves the right to reject all or any of the Bidders or bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 1.8. Each Bidder shall bear all its costs associated with or relating to the preparation and submission of its bid.
- 1.9. It shall be deemed that by submitting a bid, the Bidder has undertaken a complete and careful review of the E-Auction/Tender Document and unconditionally and irrevocably accepted the terms and risks thereof.
- 1.10. In case the day of completion of any requirement is falling due on a public holiday, the day of completion shall be deemed to be due on the next successive working day. The expression “public holiday” includes Saturday, Sunday and any other day declared to be a public holiday

by the Central Government or the State Government, as the case may be.

- 1.11. Bidder shall be responsible for any problem at the Bidder's end which may cause inconvenience or prevent the Bidder from bidding in e-auction, such as, but not limited to, failure of electricity, loss of internet connection, any trouble with Bidder's computer, etc.
- 1.12. This Tender Document is not chargeable.

2. Introduction

- 2.1. In exercise of powers conferred by Section 15 of the Act, the State Government has notified the 'Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016', as amended from time to time. The Bidders are encouraged to acquaint themselves with the updated Act and the rules made there under.
- 2.2. This Tender Document is being issued by the Competent Authority for e-auction for grant of a Quarry Lease under the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time.
- 2.3. The e-auction would be conducted in accordance with the Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time and any other order or notification issued by the State Government pursuant thereto and as per the terms and conditions of the Tender Document.

3. The Source details

- 3.1. The information regarding the Mineral Source is included in a separate “**Information Memorandum**” attached along with this Tender Document as **Annexure-I**.
- 3.2. Bidders are strongly encouraged to review the Information Memorandum.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1. The eligibility for participating in the auction shall be determined as per the terms and conditions of eligibility for participating in the auction as provided in the rules.
- 4.2. Pursuant to Rule 27 (4A) of OMMC Rules, 2016 and amendments made there under, the following eligibility conditions are required for participating in auction for quarry leases.
- (i) A person, who is an Indian national or company as defined in clause (20) of Section 2 of the Companies Act, 2013, (18 of 2013) or partnership firm as defined in Section 4 of the Indian Partnership Act, 1932, shall be eligible to participate in the auction process for grant of quarry lease.
- Explanation: - For the purpose of this rule, a person shall be deemed to be an Indian national, -*
- (a) in the case of a partnership firm, only if all the partners of the partnership firm are citizens of India: and*
- (b) in the case of an individual, only if he is a citizen of India*
- (ii) The bidder shall submit **either** the Income Tax Return of previous financial year (certified by a Chartered Accountant) showing annual income for an amount not less than the amount of minimum additional charge and the royalty together payable for the minimum guaranteed quantity for one whole year **or** submit a Bank guarantee valid for a period of eighteen months for the amount not less than the amount of minimum additional charge and the royalty together payable for the minimum guaranteed quantity for one whole year.
- 4.3. Only one application from one member/family/company/firm shall be allowed to participate in the e-auction of each Minor Mineral Source.
- 4.4. The eligibility conditions shall be used only for the purposes of determination of eligibility for participating in the e-auction. **The Selected Bidder shall be decided solely on the basis of the outcome of e-auction.**

5. Site Visit and Pre-Bid Conference

5.1. Site Visit

- 5.1.1. Site visit would commence on publication of notice inviting Tender(NIT) and would end on Bid Due Date.
- 5.1.2. Intending bidders shall be eligible to visit the Mineral Block. The site visit to the Mineral Block shall be conducted with prior notice to the Competent Authority either through an application or through the following e-mail address (mo.malkangiri21@gmail.com). The email should clearly bear the following subject line: "Site Visit for Rengabandha Stone Quarry, Mangipalli Stone Quarry & Anantapalli Stone Quarry."
- 5.1.3. During such period, the intending bidders may undertake the site visit to the Quarry at their cost and risk to ascertain for themselves the site conditions, location, communication, climate, availability of power, and any other matter considered relevant by them.
- 5.1.4. In the event an intending bidder undertakes a site visit, then such intending bidder shall be liable towards any loss or damage caused to the site and/or the person(s) having surface rights over the concerned lands, on account of any act of commission or omission of such intending bidder or its employees, authorised representatives, agents, advisors, etc.

5.2. Pre-Bid Conference

- 5.2.1. Intending bidders may seek clarifications or request further information regarding this E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 5.2.2. Any queries or requests for additional information concerning this E-Auction/Tender Document may be sent in .doc, .docx, .xls, .xlsx format only to the Competent Authority by e-mail.
- 5.2.3. The email should clearly bear the following subject line: "Queries/Request for Additional Information: E-Auction/Tender Document for "Rengabandha Stone Quarry, Mangipalli Stone Quarry & Anantapalli Stone Quarry."
- 5.2.4. Each query should contain complete details of facts, information and Applicable Law relevant to the query and also the particulars of the person posing the query. The Competent Authority reserves the right not to answer any query, including any query which is incomplete or anonymous.
- 5.2.5. The queries should be e-mailed on or before the date specified in the timeline for receiving queries.
- 5.2.6. The Competent Authority shall endeavour to respond to the queries within the period specified in the timeline for auction.
- 5.2.7. The Competent Authority shall publish the queries for which response has been provided on the MSTC portal, without identifying the source of queries.
- 5.2.8. Pre-bid conference(s) of the intending bidders shall be convened on the designated date as mentioned in the timeline at a time and place specified by the Controlling Authority. The Controlling Authority may, at its sole discretion, choose to convene the pre-bid conference through virtual mode (or a hybrid of virtual and physical modes) subject to such conditions as may be notified separately by the Controlling Authority.

- 5.2.9. A maximum of 2 (two) representatives of each intending bidder shall be allowed to participate on submission of duly issued authority letter from the intending bidder and identity documents. It is expressly clarified that no queries may be submitted beyond the last date for receipt of queries as indicated in the timeline of this E-Auction/E-Auction/Tender Document.
- 5.2.10. The Competent Authority shall endeavour to provide clarifications and such further information, as it may, in its sole discretion, consider appropriate for facilitating a fair, transparent and competitive E-Auction/Tender process.
- 5.2.11. The Controlling Authority may also on its own motion, if deemed necessary, issue interpretations and clarifications to all intending bidders. All clarifications and interpretations issued by the Controlling Authority shall be deemed to be part of the E-Auction/Tender Document. Provided, however, that any non-written clarifications and information provided by the Controlling Authority or its representatives in any manner whatsoever shall not in any way or manner be binding on the Controlling Authority.

6. Registration for e-auction

MSTC registration process:

Bidders shall have to visit MSTC website (<https://www.mstcecommerce.com>) for one time registration in the MSTC web-portal. Bidders will be prompted to validate their Mobile no and Email id for authentication. Once successfully registered, bidders will receive an email and will be prompted to deposit the registration fee of 1000/- + Applicable GST (Currently Rs 180/-) for activation of login id. Once the registration fee is paid, bidders are to ensure to upload signed bank mandate form/cancelled cheque for verification of bank details and IFSC code.

Bidders to follow the detailed guideline of registration available in the MSTC portal.

(a) Non-refundable Application fees vide Treasury Challan:

A non-refundable application fee of Rs. 1000/- Shall be deducted from the bidder's available Pre-BID EMD wallet for participation in a particular event.

(b) Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), calculated as per rule, shall be deducted from the bidder's available Pre-BID EMD wallet for participation in a particular event. The earnest money shall be a fixed amount calculated on the basis of factors as mentioned in Odisha Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016.

(c) Documents to be uploaded by bidder for participation in e-Auction through online:

The intending applicant shall submit the technical bid for grant of quarry lease for such area or areas as notified to be auctioned to the Competent Authority in the format of **Form – M (Annexure-II)** using the online electronic auction platform adopted by the Government along with the following documents and particulars, stated hereunder: —

- (i) An affidavit stating that no mining due payable under the Act and the rules made there under, is outstanding against the applicant;
- (ii) An affidavit stating that none other than him/her in the family is participating in the bidding process of the particular source and if contrary is observed, the sale if any, shall be rendered infructuous forfeiting the deposits made there under without affording any further scope of notice or hearing;
- (iii) Income Tax Return of previous financial year showing annual income for amount not less than the amount of additional charge offered and the royalty payable for the minimum guaranteed quantity for one whole year or Bank guarantee valid for a period of eighteen months for the amount not less than the amount as above;

(d). Offline Submission:

- I. All the above original documents along with proof of application fees of Rs.1000/- , proof of EMD (Print out of EMD Ledger Statement from MSTC portal) and *GSTIN Registration Certificate* has to be submitted **off-line through sealed cover to the competent authority** before the CLOSING DATE & TIME FOR TECHNICAL EVALUATION;
- II. The seal cover shall be superscripted Tender **no.** and Date-, Name of the source and source code and to be sent through courier/ RP/ Speed Post.
- III. The Bidder should submit one bid for one source in a single envelope only.

7. Bidding Process

- (a) The Technical Bid shall be evaluated to ascertain compliance of the Bidder with the eligibility conditions and requirements under this E-Auction/Tender Document. While examining the Technical Bids the Technical Committee may consider such parameters as it may deem relevant, including considerations that the Technical Bid:
- (i) is received as per the prescribed formats along with all required documents and information;
 - (ii) is received by the closing date and time for submission of bidder's information including any extension thereof;
 - (iii) is submitted electronically in the manner prescribed in *(Technical details regarding online electronic auction)*;
 - (iv) contains all the information (complete in all respects) as requested in this E-Auction/Tender Document;
 - (v) does not contain any condition or qualification;
 - (vi) only 1 (one) Technical Bid has been submitted by the Bidder for a particular source;
 - (vii) is generally considered to be in compliance in terms of any other parameters as may be considered relevant by the Technical Committee.
- (b) Only those Bidders who are found to be eligible in accordance with the terms and conditions of eligibility specified in above Clause and whose Technical Bids meet the requirements under this E-Auction/Tender Document, will be referred to as **“Technically Qualified Bidders”** (TQB).
- (c) The Technically Qualified bidders shall be intimated about their selection vide Email on/after the DATE FOR DECLARATION OF TECHNICALLY QUALIFIED BIDDER (TQB) as per Rule 27(6) of OMMC Rules, 2016.
- (d) The Competent Authority is not obliged to provide any explanation or clarification on their disqualification to Bidders who fail to qualify as Technically Qualified Bidders.
- (e) The bidders who are selected shall only be eligible for participating and bidding in the online e-Auction platform for quoting the highest additional charges through forward auction.
- (f) The forward auction shall be conducted electronically for a duration of 2 (two) hours commencing from the time as would be notified and the Technically Qualified Bidders shall submit their offer of additional charge, which needs to be in excess of the minimum additional charge notified under Rule 27(2) of the Rules by any multiple of increment of 10% of the Min Additional Charge (MAC) rounded up to the next whole number.
- (g) The closing time of e-auction will be automatically extended upto last bid time, plus 8 (eight) minutes, so that opportunity is given to other bidders for making an improved bid on that mineral block

Provided forward auction shall be conducted subject to the condition that at least two bidders are found technically qualified.

- (h) The technically qualified bidder, who quotes the highest rate of additional charge will be declared as selected bidder:
- (i) The auction process shall be annulled if none of the technically qualified bidders submits an offer of additional charge above the notified minimum additional charge.
- (j) The selected bidder shall be intimated by the Competent Authority within seven days in Form-F about the selection and terms and conditions of the lease.
- (k) Immediately after compliance of the foregoing provisions by the selected bidder, the earnest money of the unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded and the bank guarantees, if any, furnished by them, shall stand discharged.
- (l) The selected bidder shall also deposit the costs of obtaining the mining plan and environmental clearance approvals, in case those have been obtained by the Competent Authority (non-refundable) before executing the lease deed.
- (m) In the event of default by the selected bidder, the Competent Authority may issue intimation as specified in sub-rule (6) to the next highest bidder to meet the highest additional charge offered by highest bidder, who shall then be required to convey his acceptance and to make the security deposit calculated in the manner mentioned in sub-rule (7) within 7 days of receipt of intimation.
- (n) If the second highest bidder does not convey the acceptance within the time stipulated for such acceptance, the e-auction will be annulled and fresh notice inviting application for grant of quarry lease shall be issued.

8. Minimum Additional Charge

- 8.1. The Minimum Additional Charge (MAC) of the Minor Mineral Sources is mentioned in the **Annexure-I**

- 8.2. It is clarified that payment in accordance with the Final Additional Charge shall be required to be made in addition to the payment of royalty, surface rent, dead rent, amount for District Mineral Foundation, an amount towards Environment Management Fund, and fees for compensatory afforestation, and any other payments as applicable.

9. Payment of interest free Security Deposit

- (a) The Selected bidder shall be required to convey his acceptance of the terms and conditions within fifteen days of intimation regarding his selection and to deposit an amount which shall be calculated in such a way that it shall be equivalent to one-fourth of the total amount of royalty and additional charge and the amount of contribution payable to the District Mineral Foundation on the annual minimum guaranteed quantity, taken together, reduced by the amount of earnest money, which, along with the earnest money, shall be held as interest-free security deposit.

- (b) The security deposits liable to be refunded after the completion of the lease period subject to the condition that the lessee has fulfilled all conditions of lease and in case of violation of any of the conditions of lease, the security deposit shall be forfeited in whole or in part by the Competent Authority.

10. Grant of Quarry Lease

10.1 The Quarry Lease shall be granted to the Selected Bidder subject to the following:

10.1.1 The Selected Bidder shall be considered for grant of Quarry Lease upon fulfilment of following conditions:

- (a) Site visit on compliance with all the terms and conditions of eligibility;
- (b) on payment of Security Deposit to and receipt of Security Deposit by the State Government;
- (c) on obtaining all consents, approvals, permits, no-objections and the like as may be required under the Applicable Law for commencement of operations of Quarry; and

10.1.2 The Selected Bidder shall be required to execute quarry lease in Form-N within three weeks from the date of intimation of his selection if the approval of the mining plan and environment clearance has been obtained before auction, and in other cases, three weeks from the date of receipt of statutory documents in all i.e. Mining Plan, Environment Clearance, Consent to Establishment (CTE) and Consent to Operate (CTO) failing which, the intimation shall stand cancelled and the security deposit shall stand forfeited.

Provided that the Controlling Authority may, for genuine and sufficient reasons, extend the said period for not more than three months, if it is satisfied that the delay in execution of lease deed is not due to reasons attributable to the selected bidder.

Provided further that if the selected bidder failed to execute the lease deed within the stipulated time period as mentioned in Clause 10.1.2, the Selected Bidder shall be debarred from participating in the future auction of mineral Source(s) for 5 (five) years from the date of such debarment.

10.1.3 Security deposit shall be refunded after expiry of the lease period if the lessee has fulfilled all conditions of lease and in case of violation of any of the conditions of lease, the security deposit shall be forfeited in whole or in part by the Competent Authority.

10.1.4 The Controlling Authority as defined in Schedule-III of the Rule shall have power to cancel the bid duly recording the reasons thereof, if he is not satisfied with the publicity, participation of bidders and amount of additional charge quoted.

10.1.5 Where the lessee, who has quoted the highest rate of additional charge, dies after deposit of the amount specified under rule 42 or after execution of lease deed by him, such deposit or deed shall be deemed to have been made or executed by the legal heir or legal representative, if they so like.

10.1.6 The lease holder get approval for the Mining Plan and obtain the Environmental Clearance from the appropriate authority at his own expense within the specified time frame failing which the security deposit amount of the lessee shall be forfeited.

In case the mining plan or Environment Clearance for the proposed lease has been obtained by the Competent Authority, this fact, along with the cost of obtaining thereof shall be recoverable from the selected bidder.

The lessee shall be responsible for managing the environment of the source in accordance with the stipulations mentioned in the Environmental Clearance and in case of B1 category source the conditions mentioned in the Environment Impact Assessment & Environment Management Plan.

11. Payments by the Selected Bidder

11.1 The Selected Bidder after being granted of the Quarry Lease will be considered as the Quarry Lease holder on execution of the quarry lease deed in Form-N and will be required to make the payment of the Royalty and other statutory dues as under the OMMC Rules, 2016.

11.2 Environment Management Fund & DMF:

The lessee shall pay an amount equivalent to 5% of the Royalty as Environment Management Fund and an amount equivalent to 10% of the Royalty to the District Mineral Foundation

11.3 Increase in Royalty:

The rates prescribed in Schedule I& II of the rules shall be applicable and the same may be modified by the Government. The concerned lessee shall be liable to pay the increased royalty if the revised price is higher than the sanctioned royalty.

11.4 Dead Rent and Surface Rent:

The lessee shall pay Dead Rent and Surface rent every year as mentioned in the Schedule I.

11.5 Compensatory Afforestation:

The lessee shall pay the amount towards compensatory afforestation as determined by the appropriate authority.

12. Other Provisions

- 12.1. The Lessee shall submit the return in **Form-P** and annual return in **Form-K** to the Competent Authority in compliance with all the rules and regulations in force and applicable. The Lessee shall submit monthly online return/report regarding the production and dispatch of minor minerals.
- 12.2. The lessee shall afford reasonable facility for inspection of the quarry cum accounts and records pertaining to quarry operation to the Competent Authority and any other Officer authorized by the Government as per the provisions under Rule 33(16) and Rule 33(17) of the OMMC Rules, 2016.
- 12.3. The Lessee shall mark the boundary of the Minor Minerals source according to the map in the approved mining plan with a concrete pillar as stipulated under rules and make a display board in front of the source, mentioning the name of the Minor Minerals source along with the map, the name of the lease holder and the full details of the lease. All these works shall be borne by the lessee at his own expense.
- 12.4. The Lessee shall abide by all the conditions of Quarry Lease as provided under Rule 33 of the OMMC Rules, 2016 and OMMC (Amendment) Rules, 2023.
- 12.5. For any violation of provisions under OMMC Rules 2016 and its Amendments, the lessee shall be held responsible and shall be liable for appropriate legal action.
- 12.6. The Competent Authority shall have the power to rectify any error or deviation in the present E-Auction/Tender notification.
- 12.7. The Lease holder is bound to comply the instructions issued by the Competent Authority for the proper management of minor mineral sources and in case of exception/abuse, the valid lease will be liable for cancellation.
- 12.8. The Competent Authority reserves the right to cancel the E-Auction/E-Auction/Tender process without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 12.9. All the information regarding the Minor Minerals sources and auctions shall be obtained from the concerned mining office (except holidays) on official working days during the working hours as stipulated by the Government and the complete information in this regard will be available in the website <https://www.mstcecommerce.com>.

13. Fraud and Corrupt Practices

- 13.1. The Bidders and their respective officers, employees, agents and advisers shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the E-Auction/Tender process and subsequent to the grant of the Quarry Lease. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, the Controlling Authority may reject a bid, or terminate the Quarry Lease, as the case may be, without being liable in any manner whatsoever to the Bidder, Technically Qualified Bidder or the Selected Bidder, as the case may be, if the Controlling Authority determines that the Bidder, Technically Qualified Bidder or Selected Bidder, as the case may be, has, directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged in Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice, Undesirable Practice or Restrictive Practice in the E-Auction/Tender process. In such an event, the Controlling Authority shall be entitled to forfeit and appropriate the entire Earnest Money Deposit and/ or Security Deposit, as the case may be, as damages, without prejudice to any other right or remedy that may be available to the State Government under the E-Auction/E-Auction/Tender Document and/ or otherwise.
- 13.2. Without prejudice if a Bidder, Technically Qualified Bidder or Selected Bidder, as the case may be, is found by the Controlling Authority to have directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged or indulged in any Corrupt Practice, Fraudulent Practice, Coercive Practice, Undesirable Practice or Restrictive Practice during the E-Auction/Tender process, or after the execution of quarry lease or grant of the Quarry Lease, such Bidder, Technically Qualified Bidder or Selected Bidder shall be debarred by the Controlling Authority from participating in the future auction of mineral block(s) conducted by the Controlling Authority **for 5 (five) years** from the date of such debarment.
