- 3. Date of receipt and mode of submission tender paper: -** The Tenderers have to submit the sealed tender papers in complete shape through Registered Post /Speed Post only. The last date of receipt of tender paper is **26.02.2026 (5.00 PM)**. The undersigned will not be responsible for postal delay if any or non receipt of the paper in time. The name of the project for which tender paper is filled should be written legibly on the cover in which all the required papers are kept and sealed.
- 4. Date of Opening of Tender Paper:** The tender papers shall be opened on **27.02.2026 at 11.00 AM** in Panchayat Samiti, Malkangiri in presence of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives having written authorization for the purpose and the Tender Committee.
- 5. Documents to be attached:** The following documents should be furnished along with the Tender Paper's failing which the Tender Paper will be liable for rejection.
 - a. Self-attested copy of Contractor Registration Certificate.**

 - d. Self-attested copy of Caste Certificate issued by competent authorities in case of S.C. / S.T. contractors desirous of availing preference.
 - e. No Relationship Certificate in shape of Affidavit (Original) as per prescribed (Format-I)
 - f. Information regarding current Litigation, Debarring Expelling of Tendered or Abandonments of work by the Tenderer in shape of Affidavit (Original) as per prescribed (Format-II)
 - g. The bidders have to produce an original affidavit in support of the authenticity of documents attached with the tender paper as per prescribed (Format-III).
 - h. Affidavit (Original) on no criminal cases are pending and non-conviction and non-imprisonment as per prescribed (Format-IV).
 - i. The name of the project for which Tender Applications are being invited/called should be written clearly and legibly on the cover in which all the required papers are kept and sealed
 - j. Joint venture consortium agreements are not allowed to participate in tender.
 - k. **Exemption of EMD- Engineer Contractor** desirous to avail the facility of exemption of E.M.D should abide by the norms as contained in No. FA-Codes-6/2011-600W dtd. 18.01.2011 as furnished in DTCN & is required to submit an affidavit (Original) to the effect that he has not yet availed the facility / participated in the tender for more than two works (Excluding this work) during the current financial year. The name of work for which participated and the authority to whom the tender was submitted must be mentioned in the affidavit, failing which the tender will be rejected. Also he should submit the original engineering license at the time of opening of tender for recording of exemption of EMD with due verification of previous exemption, availed if any. Affidavit must clearly mention that facility of exemption of EMD has not been availed for more than two works in the current financial year, failing which the bid shall be rejected.
6. Shortfall of any required document(s), Tender Paper is liable for rejection.

7. Performance Security:

Amendment of Para-3.5.19(a)(b) of OPWD Code, Vol-I vide Office Memorandum No. – 1499 /W dated 01.02.2023 of Works Department, Government of Odisha

After careful consideration Government have been pleased to make amendment to Para-3.5.19 (a) (b) of OPWD Code, Vol.-1 with following modification.

“Security for the due fulfilment of a contract should invariably taken. The security may be taken in shape in shape of N.S.C./ Post Office Saving Bank account/ Post Office Time Deposit Account/ Kisan Vikas Patra/ Bank Guarantee in favour of the Divisional Officer (Executive Engineer, RWS&S Division, Malkangiri) from any Nationalised Scheduled Bank in India counter guaranteed by its local Branch at Bhubaneswar/ e-Bank Guarantee executed on the National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) Digital Document execution Portal towards E.M.D/ Initial Security Deposit/ any other Security deposit from the Contractor or supplier”.

Additional Performance Security in case low Bid price:

Appendix-IX, Clause36 of OPWD Code Volume-II vide Office Memorandum No. – 173 /W dated 03.01.2026 of Works Department, Government of Odisha.

- a. **ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE SECURITY:** Additional Performance Security shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under.
 - i. **Where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid, no additional**



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- performance guarantee/ security percentage required.
- II. **Where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid**, the additional performance guarantee/ security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;
 - III. **Where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid**, the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;
 - IV. the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more;
 - V. The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
 - VI. Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the bid price, in combination with other elements of the bid, appears so low that it rises materials concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the bidder, including detailed price analysis of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. If, after evaluating the price analysis, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the procuring Entity may reject the Bid/ Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
 - b. These amendments shall take effect from the date of issue of the O.M.
 - c. Accordingly, the relevant existing Codal/contractual provision stands modified with effect from the date of issue of this O.M.
 - d. This has been concurred in by the Finance Department vide **File No. FIN-WF1-MISC-0102-2025**.
8. Submission of more than one tender paper by a bidder for a single work will be liable for rejection of all such tender papers.
 9. The amount put to Tender is exclusive of GST. The intending Bidders should offer their rates which shall be exclusive of GST applicable as per norms. GST as applicable on works contract shall be paid over the bill amount at the time of payment of Bill.
 10. **Earnest money deposit:** 1% (One Percent) of the bid value in shape of N.S.C/Post Office Saving Accounts/Post Office Time Deposit Account/KVP/Bank Guarantee/e bank Guarantee pledged in favour of Block Development Officer, Malkangiri as per office Memorandum No. 1499/W dtd 01.02.2023 of work Dept. The Tender Papers without required amount of E.M.D. will not be considered and transfer or adjustment of E.M.D. is also inadmissible.
 11. On review of the last performance of the works executed through B.D.O, Malkangiri previously, the lowest -1 Tenderer may/may not be considered for the works, though he / she becomes lowest -1 Tenderer.
 12. The undersigned reserves the right either to reject any or all tenders or cancel the entire tender process without assigning the reason thereof.



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13. If the date of sale, receipt and opening of the tender as specified above happens to be holiday(s), then the process of sale, receipt and opening whatsoever will be shifted to immediate next working day at the same specified time and venue respectively without further notice. However, date of tender paper opening may be postponed as per the convenience of the authority by intimating all the concerned Tenderers through notice affixing to Notice Board at Panchayat Samiti, Malkangiri only.

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DETAILED TENDER CALL NOTICE (02/2025-26)

1. Sealed tenders in conformity with detailed tender call notice to be eventually drawn in from of the OPWD P-1 Agreement and will be received up to **5.00 P.M on 26.02.2026** by the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri for the work **"Construction of ACR building at Burudi UPS"** at a tender value of Rs. **13,89,003/- (Rupees thirteen lakh eighty nine thousand three) only** from Government Registered Contractors of R&B/N.H/RW Wings of Class **"C" & "D"** and above and will be opened on **27.02.2026** at **11.00 AM** in presence of the Tenderers or their authorized agents by the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri.
2. Tender paper received after due date & time will be rejected.
3. The contractors may obtain a set of tender documents from the Govt. website <https://malkangiri.odisha.gov.in> only and submit Bank Draft for **Rs. 6000/-** in favour of BDO, Malkangiri, payable at Malkangiri towards cost of Tender paper.
4. The Block Development Officer, Malkangiri reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason. There of the Tenderer, whose tender is selected for acceptance shall within a period of seven days upon written intimation being given with regard to acceptance of his tender shall deposit an initial security money equal to that of E.M.D. over and above the E.M.D. as stipulated in clause above and sign the agreement in the item rate contract from the P.W.D. The initial security deposit with the earnest money and the amount withheld from successive work bills according to the provisions of the item rate contract shall be retained as security deposit. Failure to execute required agreement and deposit the security money as above shall be entitled for forfeiture of the earnest money. No tender shall be finally accepted unless the required amount of security money is deposited. The written agreement to be entered into between the contractor and the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri shall be the foundation of the right of both parties and the contract shall be deemed to be incomplete until the agreement has first been signed by the contractor and then by the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri in the manner as laid down in O.P.W.D. code. The Block office, Malkangiri shall accept the security deposit in shape of N.S.C/Post Office Saving Accounts/Post Office Time Deposit Account/KVP/Bank Guarantee/e bank Guarantee Pledged in favour of the BDO, Malkangiri of any Nationalized/Scheduled Banks of India counter guaranteed by the Local Branch at Malkangiri. The document/receipt shall be furnished to the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri. Exemption will be allowed to Govt. Agencies or Engineer Contractor or ST/SC contractors.
5. **Both E.M.D. & I.S.D.** shall be refunded to the successful Tenderer after 6 months of completion of works provided that all defects if pointed out by Engineering Staff are rectified. However, the security deposit will be refunded only after audit, which is being deducted from time to time in all running as well as final bills.
6. The rate shall be quoted in words and figures. Otherwise, the tender will be liable for rejection. In case of discrepancy between unit rates and totals, the unit rate shall prevail over. The rates shall be quoted in rupees and paisa. The tender shall be written legibly and free from erasers, over writings, conversion of figures. Corrections, where unavoidable should be made by scoring out, initialing dating and re-writing.
7. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of royalties or other charges for quarrying materials. All local taxes including state sales tax and income tax, ferry and tollage charges, and other local taxes shall be paid by the contractor. The same will be deducted from the work bill if the contractor fails to produce the valid receipt in support of the payment of the above said charges/taxes.
8. If the contractor removes any materials or stock supplied to him from the site of the work with a view to dispose of the same dishonestly or for any other reason without written permission of the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri he shall in addition to any other liabilities civil or criminal arising out of such removal, liable to pay a penalty equivalent to given times rate of the materials or stock so removed according to the stipulated rate and the penalty so imposed shall be recovered from the Contractor from any sum that may then be immediately due or any time there after becomes due to the contractor or



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- from his security.
9. The contractor shall be fully liable to indemnify the BDO, Malkangiri payment of any compensation under workmen compensation Act VIII of 1923 on account of worker employed by him and the full amount of compensation paid shall be recovered from the contractor.
 10. All reinforced cement concrete work shall confirm to the detailed standard specification and shall be of proportion as per design with the specification mentioned in the tender schedule. All items of work shall be executed in accordance with the detailed standard specification of Orissa as followed by State PWD (Roads & Buildings).
 11. Shuttering and centering shall be with seasoned Sal wood planks inner width of which shall be lined with suitable shuttering made of leak proof and tight including false work as directed or alternatively steel shuttering and centering shall be used.
 12. For the purpose of the jurisdiction, in the event of dispute if any, the contractor shall be deemed to have been into within the Malkangiri District Area and it is agreed that neither party to the agreement will be competent to bring any suit with regards to the matter covered by this contract at any place outside Malkangiri.
 13. It is contractor's responsibility to correctly demarcate the lay-out and orientation of the building etc. and fixation of level pillars at site as directed by the JE or AEE. All expenditure in connection with tools and plants, instrumental materials etc., shall be borne by the contractor.
 14. After the work is finished, all surplus materials and debris shall be removed, preliminary work such as mixing plates etc., are to be dismantled and all the materials removed from the site and ground upto 30mtrs. wide from the building etc. should be cleaned and dressed by the Contractor at his own cost. The net rate quoted should be inclusive of all these expenditures. He should return all the unused Departmental materials to JE concerned.
 15. The Contractor shall not interfere with the execution of water supply or electrical fittings and other works entrusted to any other agency by the BDO, Malkangiri at the time during the progress of work.
 16. The Technical Consultant of work shall have the right to reject the scaffolding and cantering etc., made for the work and such structure if found defective in his/ their opinion.
 17. The contractor shall at his own cost make water supply for all work and make sanitary arrangements for his labour campus. The Contractors shall also arrange adequate lighting arrangement for night work, wherever at his own cost.
 18. Boiling of water arising from any reason whatsoever from the foundation, if necessary, shall be borne by the Contractor. No payment shall be made for fixing arranges bench-marks. Level pillars profiles and benching and leveling the ground whenever required. The rates quoted shall be for finished items of work inclusive of all incidental items of work.
 19. It should be understood clearly that on claim whatsoever shall be entertained as regards extra item of work or extra quantity of any item in excess of the estimate, written order must be obtained from the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri for such extra item or quantity of work.
 20. The Contractor must follow the fair wages clauses as introduced by the State Government.
 21. Except as otherwise provided in the contract, all quotation and disputes relating to the meaning of the specification, designs, drawings and instructions contained therein and as to the quality of workmanship of materials used in the work, or as the any other question claim right, matter of anything whatsoever, arising out of the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof shall be referred to the tender committee. The award of the Tender Committee shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to this contract.
 22. The contractor shall arrange at his own cost, necessary tools and plants as may be required for the efficient execution of the work and the rates quoted should be inclusive of the running and hire charges of such tools and plants.
 23. The Contractor shall submit to the Block office monthly return of the labour both skilled and un-skilled employed by him on the work. In case of non-payment, contractor is solely responsible in the labour court.
 24. No part of the contract shall be sublet without written permission of the Block Development Officer,



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Malkangiri or transfer is made by power of attorney authorizing other to receive payment on the contractor's behalf.

25. No tender documents shall be sold to the intending Tenderers on the date of opening of the tender.
26. If any further necessary information is required the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri will furnish such information but it must be in order and according to instructions.
27. Only ISI specified Cement (OPC /PPC- 53 Grade) will be used and weight of each cement bag being taken as 50Kg. Further that the Reinforcement of make SAIL/ TATA / VIZAG shall be used in the work
28. No contractor shall be permitted to furnish his tender in his own manuscript papers or letter pads.
29. In the event of delay in the supply of detailed structural designs for unavoidable reasons, reasonable extension of time will be granted on application by the contractor, but no claim for monetary compensation therefore shall be entertained under any circumstances.
30. Before quoting his rates the tenderer can inspect the site of proposed work. He should inspect the quarries and satisfy himself about the quality, availability of materials, medical aids, labour, food stuff etc., and the rates shall be inclusive of all these items, in every case the materials must comply with the relevant specification.
31. The tenders containing extraneous conditions not covered by the tender call notice are liable for rejection.
32. The Contractor shall have to furnish certificate along with the tender to the effect that he is not related to any Panchayat Samiti, Malkangiri staff.
33. Tenders shall be deemed valid and hold good till 90 days from the date of obtaining of tenders.
34. After completion of the work, the contractor shall arrange at his own cost all requisites and equipments for testing for the work of building, roads and culverts etc., if found necessary and bear the entire cost of such test.
35. Tenderers are required to submit a list of important works executed by them in the State of Odisha in the prescribed form enclosed herewith accompanied by a certificate from the concerned authority of the work in respect of satisfactory and timely completion of the work.
36. Before executing the work, contractor must erect one transparency board stating a brief note on the work to be executed and payment will be made out of estimated amount. No running bill will be paid unless transparency board is setup at the work site. Also, after the work is completed necessary correction is to be made if required over the transparency board by the executants as directed by Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri.
37. The Tenderer may at his option quote reasonable rate for each item of work carefully so that rates for one item should not be unworkably low and for other items too high. He should be able to substantiate his rates for any or all items through detailed analysis.
38. The Block Development Officer, Malkangiri reserves the right to reject any or all tenders received without assigning any reason whatsoever. The Block Development Officer, Malkangiri also reserves the right to accept any tender without assigning any reasons to other tenders.
39. The Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri shall have the power to make any alternations in or addition to the original specification, drawing, designs and instructions that may appear to him to be necessary or advisable during the progress of the work. The Contractor shall be bound to carry out the work in accordance with any instruction, which may be issued to the contractor after being signed by the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri and such alteration shall not invalidate the contract and any additional work which the contractor may be directed to do the manner, above, specification as part of the work shall be carried out by the contract on the same conditions in all respects on which he agreed to do the main work. The time for the completion of the work shall be extended in the proportion that the additional work bears to the original work shall be extended in the proportion that the additional work bears to the original contract work and the certificate of the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri shall be conclusive as to such proportion, and if the additional work included any class of work shall be carried out at the rate entered in the sanctioned schedule of rates of the locality during the period when the work is being carried on and if such mentioned class of work is not entered in the schedule of rate of the Malkangiri district then the contractor shall within seven days of the date of his receipt of the order to carry out the work, inform the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri of the rate which it is his

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intention to charge for such class of work and if the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri of the rate which it is his intention to charge for such class of work and if the Assistant Executive Engineer does not agree to this rate, he shall notice in writing be at liberty to cancel his order to carry out such class of work and arrange to carry it out in such manner as may be consider advisable provided always that the contractor shall commence work of any expenditure in regard thereof before the rates shall have been determined as lastly here in before mentioned when and in such case he shall only be entitled to the paid in respect of the determination of the rate as aforesaid according to such rate of determination of the rate as shall be fixed by the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri. In the event of dispute, decision of the Block Development Officer, Malkangiri will be final.

40. Tenderers are required to go through each clause of the item rate contract from the BDO, Malkangiri carefully in addition to the clause herein before tendering.
41. Rates quoted should be fairly reasonable. Rates containing abnormal superfluous and unworkable are liable for rejection.
42. Item of work net covered by the tender notice will be paid at the Current Schedule of Rates of the Public Works Departments, and those not covered by S.R. will be paid on actual analysis approved by the Assistant Executive Engineer, Malkangiri.
43. Standard Public Works Department specification of the Govt. of Orissa will be followed in executing the work.
44. The time allowed for carrying out the work as entered in the tender shall be strictly observed by the contractor and shall be reckoned from the date on which the written order of commence work is issued to the contractor. The work shall throughout the stipulated period of the contract be carried on with all due diligence (time being deemed to be the essence of the contractor on the part of the contractor) and the contractor shall pay the compensation and amount that equal to 1/3rd percent on the amount of the estimated cost if the whole works shown by the tender for every day that the whole work remain un commenced or during the execution of the work the contractor shall be bound, in all case in which the time allowed for any work exceed on month, to complete one fourth to whole of the work before three fourths of such times has lapsed in the event of the contractor failing to comply with the condition, he shall be liable to pay as compensation an amount equal to one third percent of the said estimate cost of the whole work for every day that the due quantity of work remains in complete provided always that the entire amount for compensation to be paid under provisions of this clause shall not exceed 10 percent on the estimated cost of work as shown in the tender.
45. Measurement will be taken and payment will be made for M.S. Rods and reinforcement grills as per the actual length and weight of M. S. Rods utilized in works. The weight of binding wires and cut pieces will not be considered for payment.
46. 3% ("C", "D" & 5% B Class above) will be deducted from each payment of bill on gross value towards security deposit money.
